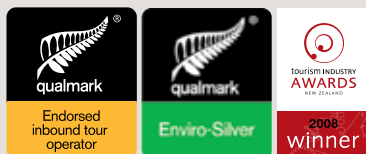

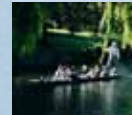

DAY 1: ARRIVE AUCKLAND

This morning see roaring geysers and boiling mud pools at the thermal area, tame trout at the springs and performing sheep and dogs at the Agrodome. Your afternoon is free - there are many activities to enjoy.

DAY 4: ROTORUA - WELLINGTON

Drive south to Taupo. Skirt Lake Taupo, and cross the volcanic landscape of the Desert Rd past the majestic peaks of Tongariro, Ngaruahoe and Ruapehu. Continue along the rugged Kapiti coastline to Wellington. Stay 2 nights in Wellington.

DAY 5: AT WELLINGTON
